FROM THE AIRPORT

Taxi (29 Euro one way)

Ask for an airport-taxi (price is 29 Euro from the airport to the hotel/BOKU – or from the hotel/BOKU to the airport). They need your name, flight number, name of the airline, time of your arrival. Ask them to confirm the reservation and carry the confirmation with you.

CAT - City Airport Train (8 Euro one way, return ticket 15 Euro)

To the station Wien Mitte – change to U4 (direction Heiligenstadt) – change to U2 at Schottenring (direction Karlsplatz) - get off at the next station Schottentor – change to bus 40 A to the conference venue (see map below)

Aiportshuttlebus (6 Euro one way, return ticket 11 Euro)

Take the airportshuttlebus (direction Schwedenplatz) – there you take the underground U4 (direction Heiligenstadt) – change to U2 at Schottenring (direction Karlsplatz) - get off at the next station Schottentor – change to bus 40 A to the conference venue (see map below)

Take the airportshuttlebus (direction Westbahnhof) – there you change to the underground U6 (direction Floridsdorf) – get off at the station Währingerstraße/Volksoper – there you change to bus 40A to the conference venue (see map below)

FROM THE RAILWAY STATION

Westbahnhof

Take the U6 (direction Floridsdorf), get off at the station Währingerstraße/Volksoper - there you change to bus 40A to the conference venue (see map below)

Südbahnhof

Take the U1 (direction Kagran, Leopoldau), change to U2 at the station Karlsplatz, get off at Schottentor, and take the bus 40A to the conference venue (see map below)

PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICE IN VIENNA

If using the public transport service in Vienna – do not forget to buy a ticket.

You can buy those tickets at:

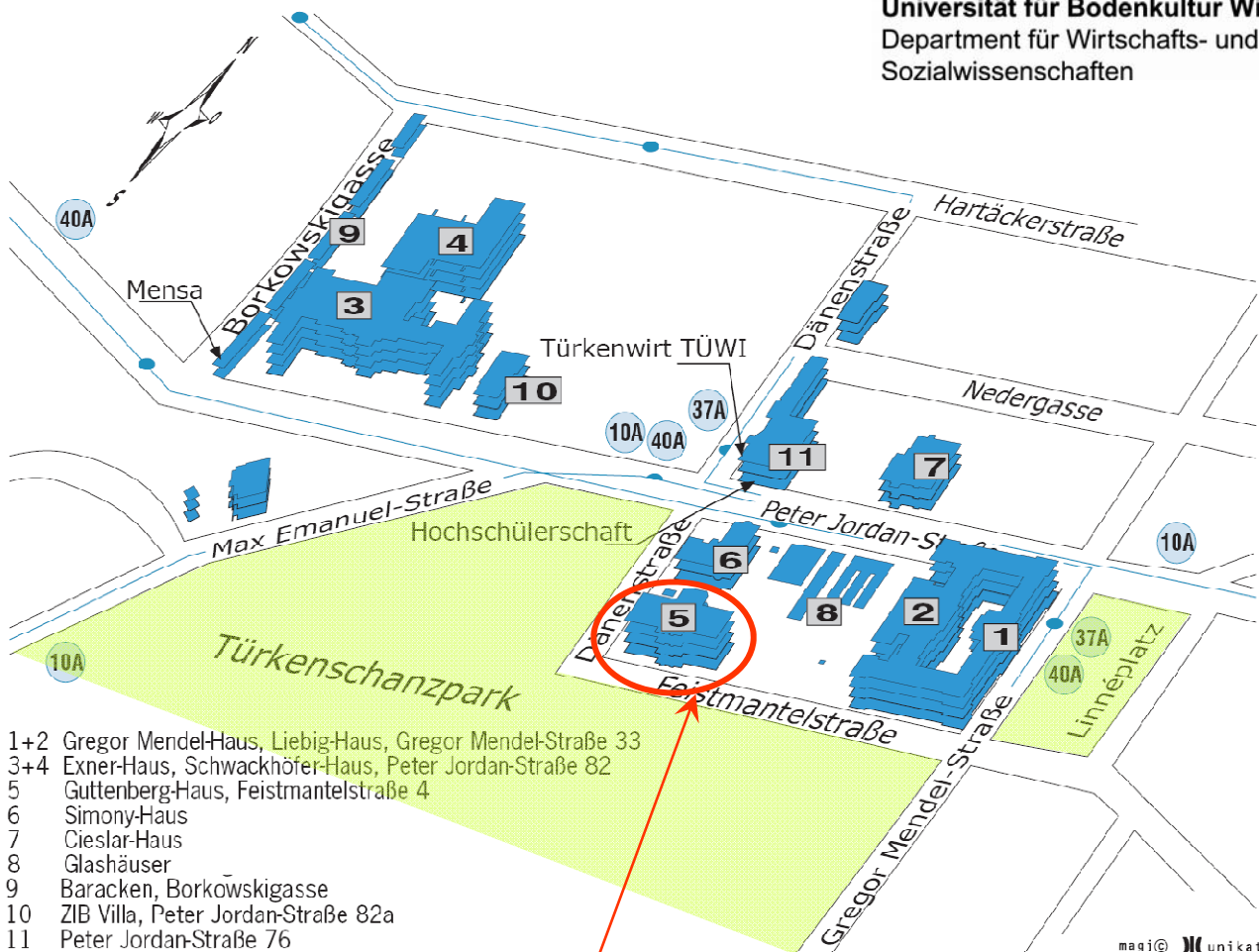
- Shops of the "Wiener Linien"
- Ticket machines in underground stations or in big tram stations
- At the driver of buses or trams (if there are no ticket machines in the bus or tram)
- At a shop called TRAFIK (they sell newspapers, cigarettes and tickets for public transport)
- Via Internet: <http://shop.wienerlinien.at/en/index.php> (some tickets are available)

Do not forget to stamp the ticket in the stamp machine - or from the driver of the bus or tram (if there is no stamp machine!)

Tickets:

- one direction
- 24 hours ticket
- 72 hours ticket
- 8 days ticket (separate days, can also be used by groups)
- shopping ticket (from 8.a.m. to 8 p.m.)
- weekly ticket (from Monday to Monday!)
